## **Tournament Rules**

- 1. Entry is open to all bowlers who have a valid membership in a sanctioned USBC Association in the state of Texas and are at least 55 years of age at the time of participation.
- 2. Tournament will consist of team and singles events. Teams will consist of four (4) members and must have at least one man and one woman on the team. Singles event will have two (2) divisions Men and Women. Handicaps will be 90% from the following scratch figures: Team 920; Singles 230. Team event may be bowled three (3) times, but only two (2) members may bowl together on a second or third team. The handicapped score from a bowler's first team event and the singles event will be counted for the all events score. **SINGLES MAY BE BOWLED ONLY ONCE.**
- 3. All Events handicapped scores will be classified by age as follows:

MENWOMENDivision 1 – 75 and overDivision 6 – 75 and overDivision 2 – 70 through 74Division 7 – 70 through 74Division 3 – 65 through 69Division 8 – 65 through 69Division 4 – 60 through 64Division 9 – 60 through 64Division 5 – 55 through 59Division 10 – 55 through 59

Age classification for All Events will be based on the bowler's age at the time of participation in the tournament.

The <u>OPTIONAL</u> fee for All Events in each division will be \$5.00 and 100% of the total fees will revert to the All Events prize fund in each division. Only those bowlers paying the optional all events entry fee will be eligible for prize money in the All Events competition, however, the bowler who has the greatest handicap score for his/her two events will be the champion in each all events division.

- Entering Average Rules:
  - a. Bowlers who are members of the Greater Austin Area USBC Association will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average of at least 21 games as listed in the 2013-2014 Greater Austin Area USBC average book. All other entrants will use their highest sanctioned league average of at least 21 games as listed on bowl.com for the 2013 -2014 season.. Averages will be verified on bowl.com by the tournament committee.
  - b. If a bowler does not have a 2013-2014 winter league average, the bowler will use his/her highest average of at least 21 games in a USBC sanctioned 2014 summer league or a current average of at least 9 games in a USBC sanctioned 2014-2015 fall league as of Oct 16th, 2014. Verification of average, signed by the appropriate league secretary, will be submitted at the time of participation.
  - c. Bowlers without an average as outlined in rules 4a or 4b will bowl scratch.
- 5. USBC Rule 319a (2), 319c and 319e will be waived.
- 6. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period, even if the prize payment has not been made, must report actual score, position and amount won to the tournament management at the time of participation for possible re-rating. Failure to comply with this provision shall be cause to forfeit the tournament entry fee and prize winnings. [USBC Rule 319d]
- 7. 100% of prize fees will be returned to tournament participants in prizes. Prize ratio will be at least one prize for each five (5) entries in team and all events, and at least one prize for each seven (7) entries in singles events. All prize money will be distributed within 30 days after the tournament ends.
- 8. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Prize money for ties in second to last place will also be combined and divided equally.
- 9. Averages of bowlers placing in prize money will be verified before distribution of the prize fund. Tournament management reserves the right to adjust handicaps upward or downward in the event verification reveals incorrectly submitted averages. It will be the <u>Team</u> <u>Captain's responsibility</u> to complete the entry form and indicate each bowler's date of birth for all events classification (Rule 3) and average (Rule 4a, b or c). If bowling singles event only, it will be the <u>individual entrant's responsibility</u> to complete the entry form correctly. <u>Team Captains</u> will have their members present at least <u>thirty (30) minutes</u> before the scheduled time to bowl.
- 10. A starting substitute must bowl all three (3) games in that event.
- 11. Pacers will not be allowed.
- 12. The use any slide aid (talcum powder, ez-slide,etc.) that would affect the approach surface is prohibited.
- 13. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament management when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device.
- 14. The Capital City Area Senior Bowling Council will have the authority to decide any matters pertaining to the operation of the tournament not covered by the above rules.
